(Jonah)

I saw the holiness of God and the work of God's Servant—his victory in defeat.
(Isaiah)

I announced the day of YHWH: a day of terror for the wicked and rejoicing for the faithful. (Zephaniah)

I condemned injustice and promoted justice; I repeatedly pictured the Messianic kingdom. (Micah)

I condemned corrupt worship but looked for God's messenger to begin restoration.
(Malachi)

I struggled to understand God's justice, but ultimately learned to trust and rejoice. (Habakkuk)

I called God's people to consider their ways and commit to God's work.
(Haggai)

I condemned others for mistreating God's people, even when they weren't acting like God's people. (Obadiah)

I revealed God's jealousy and sorrow towards sin; He feels like a husband who's been cheated on. (Hosea)

I dreamed about God's kingdom—in small things and in suffering.

(Zechariah)

I revealed God's intense desire for the holiness of His people and the holiness of His name. (Ezekiel)

I revealed the personal toll of carrying out God's messages of warnings to hard-hearted people. (Jeremiah)

I revealed the day of YHWH coming like a plague, the Spirit poured out like water and the mountains dripping with sweet wine.

(Joel)

I revealed that God rules even the greatest kingdoms of men.
(Nahum)
