Study Guide Questions:

- 1. Read 1:1-4. Outline the main points highlighted in these opening verses regarding Paul's gospel.
- 2. What was Paul's ministry objective among the Gentiles? (1:5; cf. 15:18; 16:26)
- 3. What reports have been proclaimed regarding the Roman brethren? (1:8; cf. 16:19)
- 4. Describe Paul's prayers. What does he ask of God? Why does he pray for these things? (1:8-12; cf. 15:30-33)
- 5. Why is Paul so eager to "preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome?" (1:11-17)
- 6. According to 1:17, why is the gospel God's power to save the believer? (Cf. 1:18; 3:21-26)
- 7. Memorize 1:15-17.
- 8. What key words are repeated throughout the lesson text?
