Romans: Lesson 3

The Unrighteousness of Man

Lesson Text: Romans 1:18-32

Assignment: Read the lesson text (at least) 3-5 times prior to class; if possible, reference multiple translations. Questions are provided below as an additional aid to prepare for class discussion.

Study Guide Questions:

- 1. 1:17 spoke of the revealing of God's righteousness. What revelation is contrasted with this in 1:18-32 (note specifically 1:18)?
- 2. What is the "truth" (1:18) that is suppressed by the unrighteousness of men? (1:20)
- 3. What was the <u>first</u> mistake made by the unrighteous? (1:21) Where in the progression of unrighteousness does idolatry take place?
- 4. List all the things the unrighteous did (or that were changed about them) <u>before</u> "God gave them up..."
- 5. To what did "God [give] them up? (1:24, 26, 28f) See also Psalms 81:11-16.
- 6. Consider, is Paul describing a specific subset of people in this section (e.g. Jews, non-Jews, etc.) or referring broadly to all people?
- 7. From this context, what might be the revealing of God's wrath that's referenced in 1:18?
