Study Guide Questions:

- 1. In your own words, describe the "man" discussed in 2:1-5.
- 2. How is "the judge" in 2:1 similar to and different than the people described in 1:28-32?
- 3. What should be the impact of receiving God's goodness/kindness? (2:4)
- 4. What will be the sole factor on the day of wrath which separates those who receive eternal life from those who receive wrath and fury? (2:5-11)
- 5. Consider, is the law mentioned in 2:12 and following a reference to the Law of Moses or another law? Why or why not?
- 6. In 2:13, what two ways do different translations describe what will be declared of those who do the law? How does this help us understand the faith mentioned in 1:17?
- 7. To summarize 2:17-29, what roles should and should not the law have in the lives of followers of God?
