- 4. Who receives freedom from condemnation? (8:4)
- 5. Why is "the mind set on the flesh" "death"? Why is "the mind set on the Spirit" "life and peace"? (8:7-8)
- 6. What blessings are assured to you, "if the Spirit of God dwells in you"? (8:9-11)
- 7. What "debt" or "obligation" are we under, having been set free in Christ? (8:12-13)
- 8. What blessings are assured to us as "sons of God"? (8:14-17)
- 9. Recall 5:20-21 and the original question in 6:1, "What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase?" How would you answer that question, now having studied all of 6:1-8:17?
